**Bibliology** (The Doctrine of Revelation) [General & Special]).

- I. G-d's simultaneous
  - A. incomprehensibility
  - B. knowability
  - C. facts about the Person
  - D. personal (subjective) experience of the Person
- II. G-d is the source of ALL knowledge (revelation) about Himself. He cannot be found by man through man's efforts independent of willing participation by G-d Himself. (Ps. 32:6, John 6:44)
- III. General Revelation:
  - A. Psalm 19, Romans 1:16ff: available to all mankind equally. The conscience.
  - B. Implications of the above: moralistic & eschatologic (Romans 1:18ff espec.)
- IV. Special Revelation (Extra-Biblical):
  - A. Several Tools & Devices (Ryrie pp.63ff)
  - B. Every person's time of visitation.Ps. 32:6, Luke 19:44 (al yad Matt.3:2, 4:17, 10:7, Mark 1:15) within reach
- V. The Scriptures
  - A . Autopistic View
    - 1. Gen. 1:1 no argument offered at intro.
    - 2. Downside: [intellectual in-breeding produces the 6,000 year non-dilemma.]
    - 3. Misapplication of "Special & General Revelation"
  - B. Axiopistic View
    - 1. Deut 18: 21ff (empirical proofs offered in specific response to the question, "How?")
    - 2. <u>Pattern throughout Scriptures</u> of G-d offering proof before requiring obedience. John 20:24 (Thomas), Isaiah 7:10-11, Judges 7:10-15 (Gideon)
- VI. Axiopistic Information
  - A. The framework: Deut 18:, Zech 1:6, Luke 16:31 Moses & Prophets
  - B. Examples: Isa 7 (Efraim's fall); Isa 44-45 Cyrus; Jer 29:11 (70 years in Babylon); Isa 11 (the second recovery of the Jewish nation from exile); Daniel 11 Walvoord's exegesis.
  - C. Science: Acts 17:26 (one blood), Isa. 40:22 circle of the earth (Columbus), stretches out the heavens ... and spreads them out as a tent to dwell in (Hubbel & Red Shift), Job 22:14 circuit of heaven ("warp": i.e.;space curvature); etc.
- VII. Practical Applications and Implications
  - Deut 6:4 Hear (obey) O Israel! The L-rd our G-d, the L-rd is One.
  - Ps. 96:5 For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the LORD made the heavens.
  - Egypt as a type of G-d's loving dealing with the entire planet. Exod. 7:5 "Then they will know ..." compare with Ezek 36 & 36 expressions vis a vis Islam, etc.
    - G-d revealed Himself to Egypt as morally indignant due to sin. (re: Gen'l Revelation)
